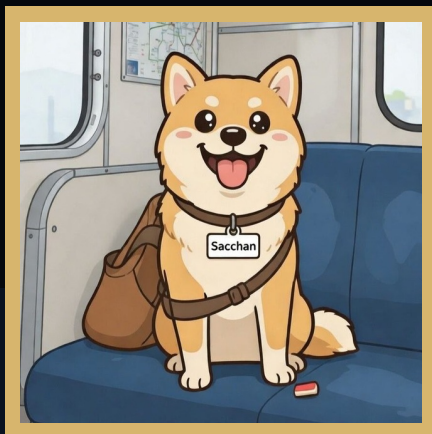




Sacchan Token

Small Contributions. Massive Impact.

A premium Web3 community network inspired by the true story of Sacchan, the Osaka dog a whole town fed — a living example of decentralized generosity.

01 What Is Sacchan?

Sacchan was a famously chubby dog who lived in Osaka, Japan. His owner noticed he kept gaining weight and could not understand why. A 1992 investigation by the television show Knight Scoop revealed the answer: Sacchan walked the same route through town every day, and dozens of people fed him along the way.

Shop owners, station workers, neighbors, residents, and complete strangers all contributed small acts of generosity. No single person was responsible for him. Instead, an entire decentralized network of people collectively kept him healthy, happy, and loved.

Small Contributions. Massive Impact. — that is the philosophy behind SAC.

02 The Legend, Step by Step

1 Owner notices the change

Sacchan keeps getting bigger, and curiosity turns into investigation.

2 The route is traced

A reporter follows the dog through Osaka streets, station fronts, and shop corners.

3 Dozens of hands feed him

Shop owners, workers, neighbors, and strangers all offer snacks, meals, and affection.

4 A town becomes a network

No single sponsor — only distributed generosity creating collective value.

03 From a Town to a Blockchain

The story of Sacchan is a real-world picture of how decentralized networks create value. Map the town onto a blockchain and the parallel is almost exact:

CONTRIBUTORS

The town: Many people contribute in town

The network: Many users contribute in the network

COORDINATION

The town: No central coordinator

The network: No central authority

VALUE CREATION

The town: Shared care creates growth

The network: Shared incentives create ecosystem value

OUTCOME

The town: Sacchan becomes a beloved mascot

The network: SAC becomes a shared community asset

04 What Is SAC?

SAC is the token representation of Sacchan's collective model. It is designed so that many small contributions — participation, support, and engagement — add up to meaningful shared value, with no central controller required.

SAC exists to reward participation, coordinate a community, and grow an ecosystem the way the town grew around one dog: organically, and together.

- Reward Token — recognize contribution and participation
- Governance Token — give the community a real voice
- Community Incentives — fuel campaigns and collective action
- Microtransactions — enable many small, frictionless exchanges
- Ecosystem Access — unlock features across the network
- Future Staking — align long-term supporters with the project

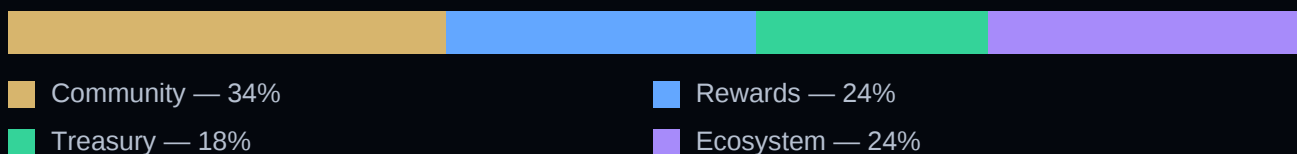

PHASE 1

Story & Community

Build the legend, launch the community, and establish the identity.

PHASE 2 Token Launch	Introduce SAC with transparent token mechanics and fair participation.
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PHASE 3 Reward Ecosystem	Activate contribution-based rewards and community campaigns.
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PHASE 4 DAO Governance	Expand collective decision-making and proposal voting.
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PHASE 5 Global Community Network	Scale the town spirit into a worldwide network of supporters.

Q. Who was Sacchan?

Sacchan was a famously chubby dog from Osaka who became a local legend after a 1992 Knight Scoop investigation.
